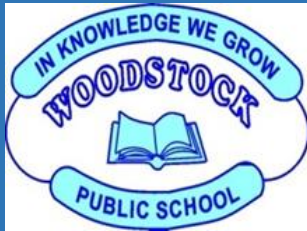

KINDER ORIENTATION 2025

Fostering Excellence Through Learning

Woodstock Public School values the importance of early childhood learning. For this reason we run a Kinder Orientation Program each year in Terms Three and Four.

The first year of school in NSW is called Kindergarten – or 'Kindy'. Your child is allowed to start school on the first day of first term as long as they turn 5 by July 31 that year. All NSW children must be enrolled in a primary school in the year they turn 5.

Term 3 Kinder Orientation - Half days from 9:00am - 12pm weekly on Fridays.

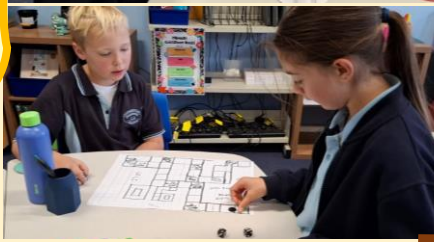
Dates:
